





Full Height Shutters

Matching the number of full height panels to the number of glass panes in your window will offer clean lines and an elegant look.


Full Height with Midrail








Tier-on-Tier




Solid Shutters

Solid shutters have become increasingly popular and can be styled to offer the charm of a French farmhouse or the elegance of a Georgian townhouse. Available with a Solid Raised insert or Shaker style, these shutters offer the best in-room darkness, but unlike the slatted styles, they do need to be opened back each day. A combination style shutter (part solid, part slatted) can give more flexibility and light.







Track Systems

We offer a variety of installation options to suit different door sizes. For wider openings typical of large bi-folding glazed doors, customers should consider a tracked option. Tracked shutters work wonderfully as both doors and room dividers. Their shutter panels glide effortlessly across a discreet track system, for smoother opening and closing.

Tracks are available with hinged bi-folding panels, free moving hinged pairs, or with our double track system which allows the front and back to bypass each other.





Light Reducing Blinds

'Shutter&Blind' is an innovative style that includes an integrated light-reducing blind within the frame behind your shutter panels. Offering almost complete room darkness, they're also great insulators, helping to keep your space cool in the summer and warm in the winter.








Shapes

Paints & Stain Finish






Shutter Details

Slat Size Options




Your choice of slat size will be dependent on the look you're hoping to achieve. The smaller slats offer a more traditional look, whereas the larger ones feel more contemporary. Typically, it's best to keep them in proportion with your windows. The 76mm and 89mm are a great choice to suit your whole house. The slats have an elliptical shape. You can also choose an 'Urban slat', which has a rebated edge to lie flat when closed.

Control Rod Options




Hidden Tilt Rod

An in-stile tilt rod that's completely hidden within the panel's stile. To open and close the slats, simply adjust any one of the attached slats and all slats will open in unison.




Clearview Tilt Rod

A similar look to the Hidden but with a discreet aluminium tilt rod at the rear of the shutter panel.



Central Tilt Rod

A vertical rod on the front centre of the panel. This links the shutter slats together and allows the slats to open and close in unison. The classic plantation shutter look.



Offset Tilt Rod

Like the Central rod but positioned offset to the hinge side. This can be useful for special shaped shutters.
